SUFFRAGETTE/SUFFRAGIST PROJECT COMMITTEE UPDATE

May 6, 2018

Attendees: Linda Morgan, Carroll Schleppi, Chris Zurbuchen, Molinda Lauxmiller

1. The committee met on May 1st at the Main Metro Library at 6:00 and discussed the following points:
2. During a discussion of the project at an earlier general MVAQN meeting Molinda agreed to lead, or chair, the project committee. According to the definitions established by the Board on April 21, 2018 that role may now be considered Project Manager.
3. Molinda will provide meeting notes to those members participating on the committee and to the MVAQN secretary.
4. It was reiterated that the quilts for this project should be submitted by July 30, 2018 so that the exhibition chair has adequate time to organize scheduled exhibit installations. The quilts can be brought to the July meeting.
5. The committee will establish a secure storage location for the quilts during the duration of the project.
6. Linda Morgan clarified the purpose of the 19th Amendment Adventure Clipboards. Her intent in offering the clipboards is to encourage journaling during the process, documentation of the process, as well as to display them with exhibits of the quilts. Use of the clipboard is voluntary and may be partially or fully completed according to each participants wish.
7. Currently potential exhibit venues include: Metro Library Main, UD, WSU, Yellow Springs Arts Council Gallery, Sinclair, Woodbourne Library Grand Re-Opening. Members are encouraged to explore other options and contact Carroll Schleppi, Exhibition Chair, to coordinate planning and scheduling.
8. Shannon inquired about the wall cards to be exhibited with the quilts. It was agreed that a more extensive description, limited to an 8 x 11 card size, can be submitted by the exhibitor.
9. Chris Zurbuchen will ask Rosemary Ramsey if she will coordinate the completion and exhibition planning of the Mother Goose Suffrage Nursery Rhymes blocks.
