Yellow Springs Arts Council (YSAC) update from Chris Z:

Show put up August 12 at 10 am. *Contact Chris Z. to help with setup.* Mother Goose quilts will not be part of this show due to space.

Chris Z. needs a completed form for your quilt to exhibit at YSAC. The committee has not yet decided which quilts will be hung at the Arts Council, but a form is needed asap. We are looking at the space at 1:00 Wednesday, July 24. Anyone is welcome.

YSAC Reception Friday August 16 6-9 pm. We bring refreshments. *Contact Chris Z. to signup even if you will not be present it would be appreciated.*

YSAC September 15 talk from 2-4 pm. The Yellow Springs Historical Society is hosting our presentation at the YSAC. They will do room setup, AV, etc. Free. They will do publicity and refreshments. Take down of the show will be after the talk, around 4:30 p.m.

Chris Z. also needs signup for hosting several Saturdays from 1-4

Fran will take quilts to store until Patterson Homestead show on October 1.

The group decided to meet at the YSAC for our August 17 meeting at 1:30. We can then be available to host that day and answer any questions from interested passersby.

Chris Z. encouraged us to renew our membership to the YSAC after it expires at the end of September.

Carroll reminded us that the library owns the Electra Doren quilt and will show it periodically at branch libraries so it will not always be available for all shows. We can have it for Patterson Homestead. Also, the Dayton Library wants to photograph our Mother Goose quilts as they are mounted in order to print in a large format booklet. Carroll will send out a “permission to photograph” form to give us the option

to not participate in this. She also thought that Woodbourne Library has an interest in showing Mother Goose. Other possibilities of showing quilts: Rosewood Art Gallery and other Dayton History locations.

Carroll is also working on a publicity sheet to cut up and give out. She will email.

Deb Bentley asked for any pictures from the July 14 talk to be sent to her to put on our Facebook page.

New Business: Dee Dadik and Molly Butler will do a quilt Appraisal for October 19th's meeting.

Jennifer is the contact person, and handed out paperwork. If you are interested, contact her for a questionnaire and time signup. They will be doing quilt appraisals in the morning and then will give a short talk about doing appraisals at our 1:30 meeting time. We voted to buy them lunch from DLM, as they requested that lunch be provided. It was voted for our treasury to pay for their mileage fee. We voted that Jennifer can sign their contract and send back. Jennifer will be at the church all day (room 13). If you want a quilt appraised, please fill out a questionnaire ahead of time to save time (Jennifer will send via email). The cost of each appraisal is \$50 per written appraisal and \$30 for verbal consultation paid by the quilt owner.

Carroll said there will definitely be no Aullwood show in the foreseeable future. Also, the Dayton Library wants to photograph our Mother Goose quilts as they are mounted in order to print in a large format booklet. Carroll will send out a permission to photograph form to give us the option to not participate in this.
